Appellation: Finger Lakes

Tasting Notes: Oak aged. Dry and medium bodied with hints of cherry. An elegant food friendly wine.

Grapes Composition: 100% Pinot Noir

Type: Red

RS: 0.5%

Alcohol Content: 12%

Bottle Size(s): 750mL

Food Pairings: Turkey, game dishes, roasted or smoked meats, lamb, ham or seafood. Mild or creamy cheese.

Vintage Notes: Vintage was an average year for Casa Larga as far as weather.

Viticulture Notes: The grapes used in this Pinot Noir are cared for specifically by the vineyard team. They perform a great amount of hand thinning & leaf removal to open up the canopy. This allows for greater sun exposure to enhance the sugars. Only the primary bunch of grapes is used in this wine. This allows the vine to focus all nutrients on the primary bunch, providing a higher quality grape.

Winemaking Notes: After pressing, the winemaking team uses the punch-down technique to ensure full color and flavor. This also allows for gentler extraction of the tannins, preventing harsh mouth-feel.
