Tasting Notes: Extraordinary aromas of tropical fruit, subtle oak, vanilla and spice. Medium bodied with a pleasing finish.

Food Pairings: Curry or smoky dishes. Tropical or dried fruit dishes.

Viticulture Notes: This varietal is very challenging to grow. Warm years seem to be better for the grapes because they are very cold sensitive. Viognier requires the vines to be thinned quite frequently.

Additional Notes: The Viognier grape originated in France, and is also grown in California, Argentina, and Virginia. Very few New York wineries make a stand alone Viognier, as it is typically used for blending.
